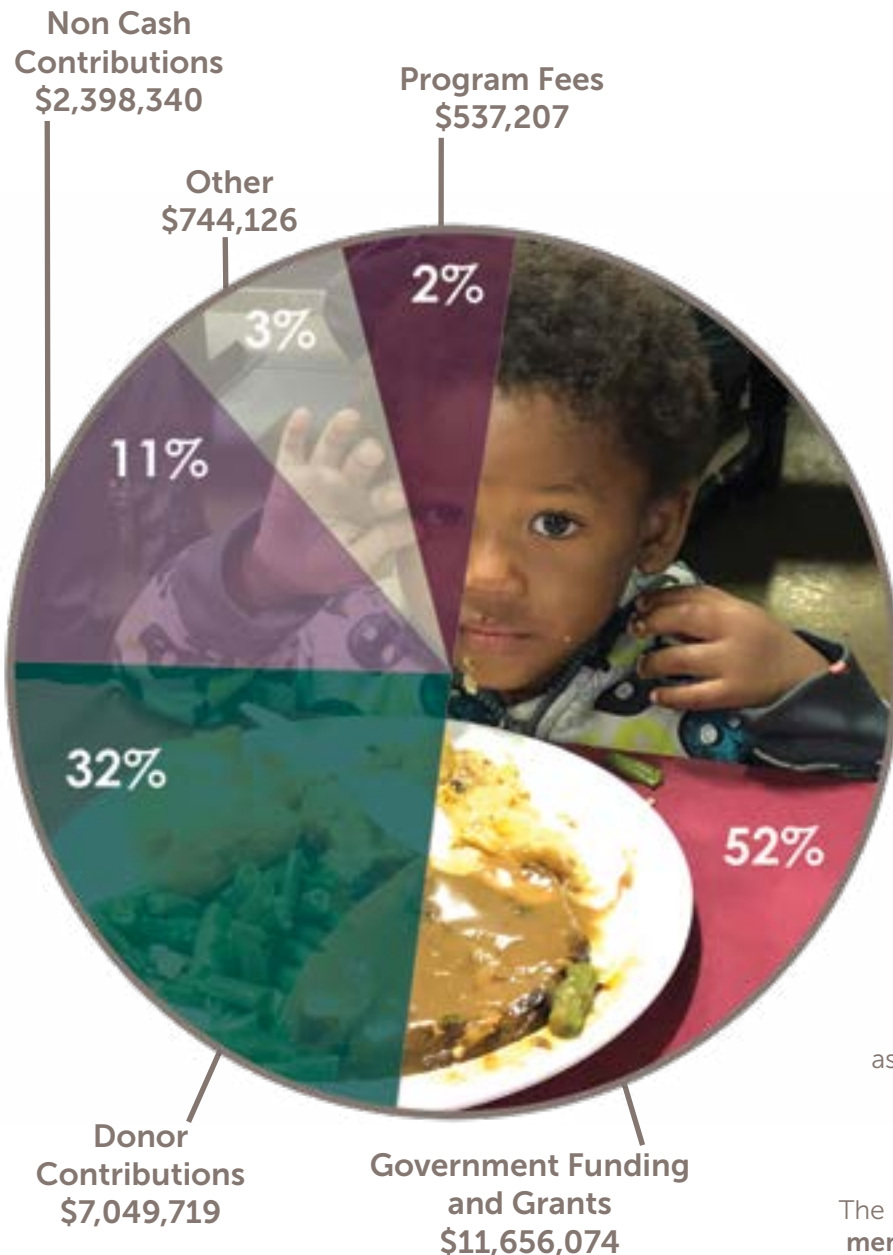

Catholic Charities includes 16 diverse programs designed to give help, hope and transform the lives of some of the most vulnerable men, women and children in our southern Nevada community regardless of race, religion, or creed.



FISCAL YEAR ANNUAL REPORT

FAMILY SERVICES

Social Services provided assistance to help prevent temporary hardship from becoming a long term crisis for families and individuals. This fiscal year **12,626 vulnerable people** were helped through the Client Services office.

Women, Infants, and Children (WIC) Program facilitated **61,811 visits** at two WIC offices, providing mothers, fathers and children with supplemental food and nutritional education.

FOOD SERVICES

The **Hands of Hope Community Food Pantry** offers a grocery store setting to allow clients to choose the best items for their families. More than **1.2 million pounds** of food were given out to **59,071 people** in need throughout the year.

St. Vincent Lied Dining Facility served an average of **750 meals** every day to men, women and children free of charge or at a reduced cost. In addition to the daily meal service, **12 festive celebratory feasts** were served during the year.

Meals on Wheels Senior Nutrition delivered more than **763,000 meals** to homebound seniors, conducted **4,230 in-home assessments** and offered **Medical Nutrition Therapy** to clients who needed individualized nutrition interventions.

SENIOR SERVICES

Senior Case Management Helped **4,280 seniors** remain independent by assessing overall needs, locating community resources, coordinating services, advocating on their behalf.

HOMELESS & HOUSING (RESIDENTIAL) SERVICES

The **Emergency Night Shelter** provided **172,259 homeless men** with a place to sleep and access to toiletries, towels, restroom and shower facilities. The **Day Shelter** provided services to **70,888 men**. The **Renewing HOPE Program** helped **234 men** transition from homelessness to self-sufficiency. The **St. Vincent Apartments** provided low-income housing to **120 men and women**.

GIVING HELP

MIGRATION AND IMMIGRATION SERVICES

Migration and Refugee Services (MRS)

resettled **806 people** in Nevada, seeking refuge or asylum from persecution around the globe.

Catholic Charities of Southern Nevada is recognized on the federal level as the State Refugee Office in Nevada. In addition to this, our agency is one of three local agencies to carry out resettlement services in the state. Catholic Charities provides Case Management, Employment Services, Cultural Orientation and Training classes to each client to help them assimilate to U.S. culture and eventually become U.S. citizens. **Catholic Charities Migration and Refugee Employment** secured **253 jobs**, while our **English Language Program** provided classes for **766 students** and more than **43,659 hours** in our classrooms and computer laboratory.

Immigration Services provided low cost legal assistance and counseling to an average of **300 immigrants** each month, helping them secure benefits such as: naturalization, employment authorization and lawful permanent residence.

FACILITIES MAINTENANCE AND HOUSEKEEPING

Staff oversaw the operations and cleanliness of our eight acre campus, including the daily laundry and sanitation needs of the day and overnight shelters.

CATHOLIC CHARITIES STAFF

During the fiscal year of 2019, **228** dedicated full and part-time employees carried out the mission of Catholic Charities of Southern Nevada.

SPECIAL EVENTS

During special events throughout this fiscal year, we were able to give out Thanksgiving Turkeys and seasonal items to **3,353 families**, provided more than **6,641 Christmas toys** to children, and celebrated Easter by giving out **864 Easter Baskets** to families in need.

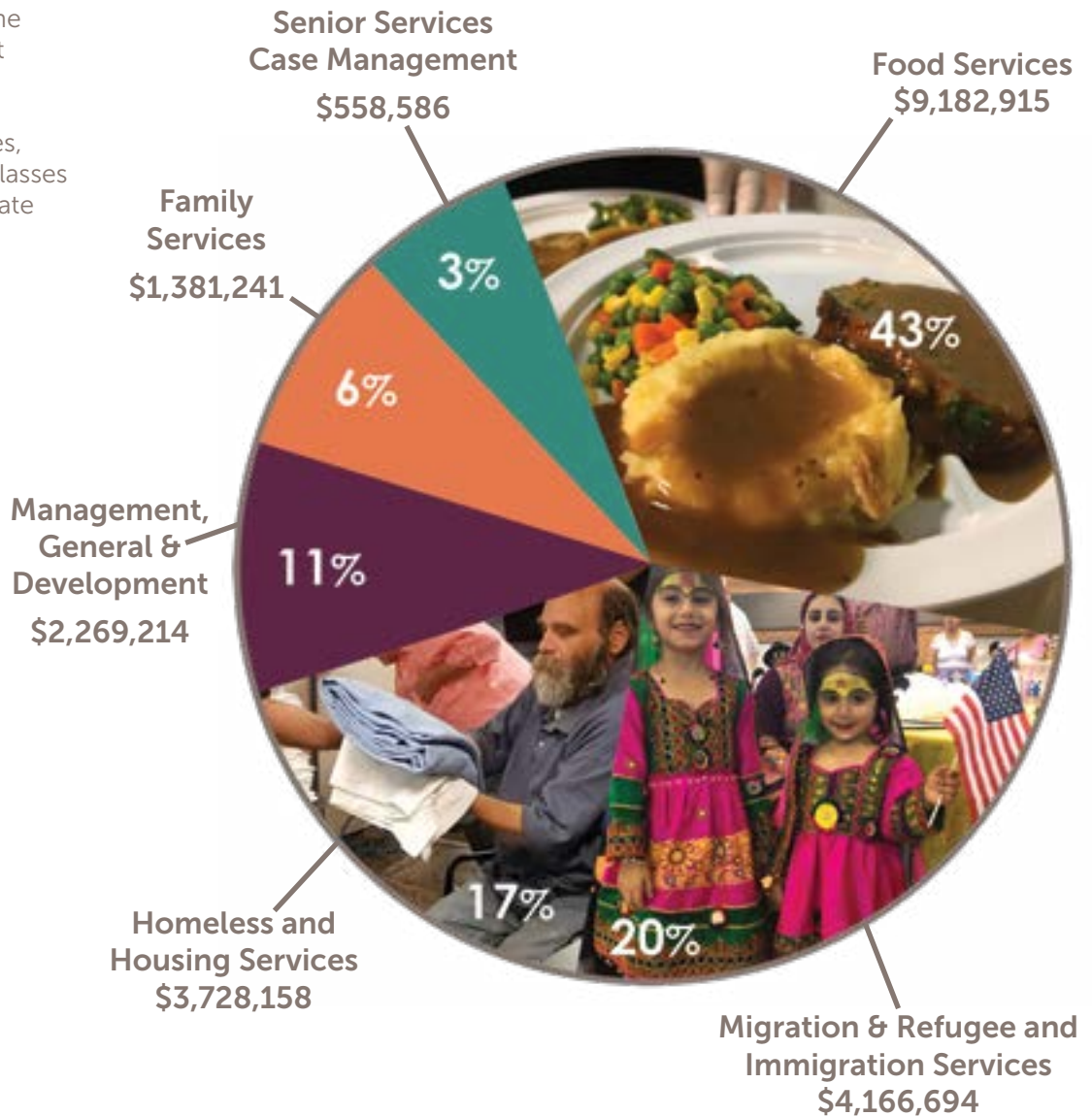
